Dive deeper into an educational expedition with a sea turtle expert. During this 3-day educational adventure, you will learn about sea turtles and have a unique opportunity to witness a remarkable natural phenomenon, where thousands of sea turtles nest simultaneously in an event called an arribada. A sea turtle expert will accompany you on your journey as you observe sea turtles at different stages of their life cycle. Learn first-hand about the research and community initiatives at the Ostional National Wildlife Refuge that protect this special place.

Activities include:

- Volunteering with a sea turtle project
- Boat excursion to observe sea turtles in the ocean
- Snorkeling the reef at a secluded beach
- Walking tour to observe nesting turtles at night
- Turtle hatchery tour
- Exclusive documentary features

Duration: 3 days

DAY 1: SEA TURTLES

After an early breakfast, head out on a boat excursion where you will observe sea turtles in the Pacific Ocean. Afterwards, snorkel and relax on a secluded beach, and enjoy a typical Costa Rican lunch with a fantastic view. On your way back down the coast, learn about the Ostional National Wildlife Refuge and visit a sea turtle hatchery. Rest and enjoy a free afternoon in Nosara.

Costs Included: round trip transportation to/from Guiones, boat trip, breakfast, snacks, and dinner.

DAY 2: CONSERVATION

Take a morning stroll down the beach as you learn how to identify tracks to monitor sea turtle nesting activity with a local sea turtle project. Enjoy a free afternoon in paradise. At night, you will have the opportunity to observe nesting turtles first-hand during a walking tour at Ostional Beach.

Costs Included: arribada tour, local guide fee, round trip transportation to/from Ostional, breakfast, and dinner

DAY 3: SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Enjoy a relaxing, free morning. After breakfast, our facilitator will share how technology is being used for scientific research at the Refuge. Observe the arribada through a virtual reality experience with 3D models of sea turtles. Learn about initiatives to protect the Refuge. Enjoy the last of your free time in Nosara before our goodbye dinner at La Luna Restaurant in Playa Pelada.

Costs included: breakfast, interactive presentation, and dinner

OLAS VERDES HOTEL

ADDITIONAL \$55–\$176 PER NIGHT PAX (TAX INCLUDED)

This luxurious, low-key, and LEED Platinum Certified hotel will help ensure you have maximum relaxations and minimum impact on the environment during your stay. This hotel is exceptionally located within 50 m of the beach and walking distance to the center of Guiones. Amenities include breakfast at the on-site restaurant, pool, on-site surf school, and bikes for your use. Enjoy a luxury suite with a shared living room, mini-fridge, coffee maker, microwave oven, wet bar, breakfast seating area, and a shared bedroom with a queen size bed and single bed, and air conditioning. The on-site restaurant also offers local lunch and dinner dishes (casado-style). Reservations for large groups must be coordinated at least 24 hrs in advance.



GREEN SANCTUARY HOTEL

ADDITIONAL \$25–72 PER NIGHT PAX (TAX INCLUDED)

This recycled container hotel offers a functional, comfortable, and sustainable stay at an unbeatable price. This hotel is just a short 700 m walk through the jungle from the beach and close to the center of town. Amenities include breakfast, air conditioned rooms, a pool and yoga deck. Shared bedrooms have a double and single bed with a private bathroom.

DISCLAIMER TURTLE TOURS:

While we can never guarantee turtle behavior, our trip dates are carefully planned to maximize the likelihood that you will see the arribada phenomenon. Turtle tours will be scheduled at the last minute, based on sea turtle behavior and recommendations of the local guide association. In the event an arribada does not occur, we will go on a turtle tour to see turtles nesting solitarily. A local, certified guide will accompany us on the beach and ensure we have a maximum chance of seeing turtles and a minimal impact as we observe them. The facilitator will accompany you on the tour and offer an exclusive pre-tour orientation and interactive tour materials.
